Who We Are

Kurling for Kids (K4K) is a Canadian, 100% volunteer-run charity that raises funds for children's hospitals and family-support initiatives. Since 1999, K4K has brought communities together through fundraising events with a strong focus on curling, raffles, and special events.

What Student Volunteers Can Do

- Help at fundraising events (evenings and weekends)
- Assist with event setup and teardown
- Support registration tables and guest check-in
- Assist with fundraising activities under supervision
- Provide behind-the-scenes event logistics support

What to Expect

- Most volunteering takes place on weeknights or weekends
- Roles are short-term and event-specific
- Volunteers are supported by experienced K4K team members

Volunteer Hours

Where applicable, Kurling for Kids can confirm volunteer hours based on actual participation in approved activities. Requirements vary by school and are handled on a case-by-case basis.

Important Notes

- K4K does not place volunteers directly in hospitals
- Volunteer roles are coordinated in advance and depend on upcoming events
- All student involvement must align with K4K policies and event needs
